# Three Ways to get there

## 1) Accelerate inclusive, sustainable economic growth

- Maximizing *finance for development* (the “Cascade Approach”)
- Crowding in more private sector investments
- Win-win solutions (Egypt, Turkey)

## 2) Build resilience to shocks and threats

- The largest funder of climate-related investments (28% of the portfolio by 2020)
- Refugees (Concessional Financing Facility)
- Pandemic Emergency Financing Facility (pandemic insurance)

## 3) Invest more in people

- *Correlation between economic growth and investments in human capital*
- The Human Capital Project (a ranking to measure countries’ stock of human capital and their investments in things that build capacity such as nutrition, healthcare, education)
- Accelerate innovative and results-based financing for human capital investments. Data. A broad coalition that includes all stakeholders – MDBs, IFIs, governments, civil society and private sector.

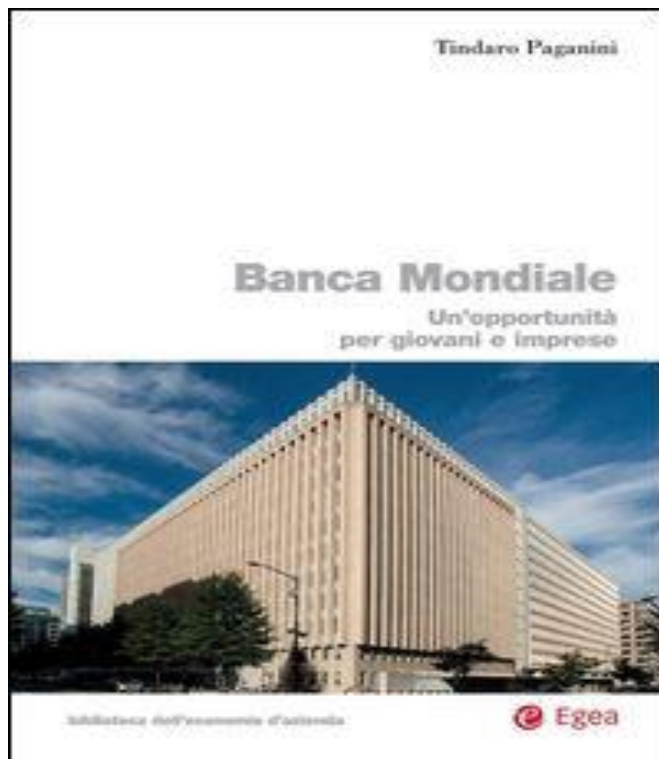
